# JCI Mocks Local Students

Every year during the months of February and March students in a south Dublin school get ready for what promises to be an exciting few weeks in their school.

JCI Dun Laoghaire has just completed another very successful project in the school with help from some of their colleagues from JCI branches in Castleknock, Dublin and Fingal. The project has been running for over 20 years in conjunction with St. Laurence College in Loughlinstown and this year over 150 students were interviewed over 3 Saturday mornings in February & March. These interviews are part of the Sixth and Seventh year programmes in the school. As part of the project, JCI members interview the students and give them feedback on their performance, as well as offering them advice on their CV's. The students will make use of this advice when they are applying for real interviews. The positive feedback given to JCI over the

years and the buzz it creates in the School among students makes it a worthwhile project for all involved.
