

## **7 Steps to Success Award Program**

The Junior Chamber Ireland 7 Steps to Success Award is awarded in recognition of a new member's involvement in the organisation. It is open to all members in their first 2 years of Membership of the organisation or of a new local branch and aims at encouraging members to become involved in a wide variety of Junior Chamber Activities.

It is awarded when 7 out of 10 activities are achieved. When you have attained this level, you can fill in the application form below and return it to your Chapter President, who will sign it and return it to the National Director of Individual Development.

Your Certificate will be presented to you at a National event by your National President. **Closing date for receipt of entries for presentation at National Convention is 11<sup>th</sup> September 2004**

Remember all seven activities must be completed within a calendar year and no one event can qualify as 2 activities.

**Local Presidents and National Executive Members are exempt from this award.**

	<b>Activity</b>	<b>Date Completed</b>
<b>1</b>	Attend any 2 local, regional or national training events (each of at least 2 hours duration).	
<b>2</b>	Make a significant contribution to a project, such as being an active member of the project committee.	
<b>3</b>	Speak in Public for a minimum of 3 minutes (this could be in local, regional or national debate or competitions, or giving a presentation on behalf of your Chapter).	
<b>4</b>	Show involvement in at least 3 social events at local, regional or national level.	
<b>5</b>	Contribute in the organisation of an International visit or twinning event at home or abroad.	
<b>6</b>	Attend as a full delegate at any regional, national or international event (i.e. Regional Training day, National Council Meeting, European or World Conference).	
<b>7</b>	Recruit a new member (who officially joins the organisation).	
<b>8</b>	Contribute an article or photograph that is published in your local or national newsletter/website.	
<b>9</b>	Complete or help to complete an award entry for National or International E-Award competitions.	
<b>10</b>	Complete a written report on activities undertaken for this award (maximum 5 pages, including benefits you have gained).
